



What happens at a Pamper Party?

A few days before your party, we will send you a timetable by email which details the running order of treatments and the therapists that guests have been assigned to. This gives you the opportunity to let us know of any changes to slots so that this can be passed onto therapists.

Your therapists will arrive approximately 15-20 minutes before your party start time with their equipment and a copy of the timetable. You can feel confident that we have taken all the necessary steps to make sure that everything runs smoothly!

Room(s) separate from your main party area will be needed for each therapist to work in. It is important that there is sufficient space for the therapist, so if you are in any doubt about room size please check when booking.

We recommend that the host provides light nibbles and refreshments. Alcoholic consumption should be kept to a minimum prior to treatment.

The host will be responsible for collecting cash payments for treatments and passing the funds to the therapist at the end of the evening. Debit/Credit card payments will be processed by the therapists either during a break or at the end of the evening (this information will be detailed on the timetable we prepare in advance).

What areas do you cover?

Because we are based in Kirkintilloch, the outskirts of Glasgow, we cover most areas within Central Scotland. If you have any questions regarding the areas we cover, please contact us.

The therapists' travel costs and downtime are mostly covered by treatment costs. For some promotional prices, a fixed travel cost fee of £15 may be levied. This will always be mentioned upon booking and be part of the deal terms and conditions.

What happens if I need to change the number of guests?

You should let us know as soon as possible (preferably 21 days prior to the date of your party) as this may affect the number of therapists we send to your party.

How long does the party last?

The party usually lasts between 4 to 6 hours depending on the number of guests and treatments requested.

What should guests wear?

Guests should wear comfortable clothing that can be removed easily if having a massage treatment. Guests may wish to bring a robe with them.

Do I have to let you know about guests' medical conditions?

Therapists will health screen prior to commencement of treatment. However, if either the host or their guests have any concerns about the suitability of a treatment, please call us and we can advise if the treatment is appropriate.
